General Information

This event is designed for all age levels and playing ability.

Entry Deadline is Sept. 30th .

No refunds will be given after this date for any reason.

Each team MUST have four players on the roster. Changes on the roster will not be accepted after the entry deadline. Players are only allowed to be on one team in the tournament.

Teams must compete in the level of their oldest player. Players will be asked for ID and proof of age at check in. For the co-ed division you must have at least two females on your roster.

The winners of each level will be awarded a cash prize. The prize will vary based on the number of teams in each division however it will not exceed \$250.

We ask that all parents and fans sit upstairs in the bleachers. Our workers will work hard to do a great job. We ask that you support your team in a positive manner. The directors of this tournament reserve the right to remove any unruly fans from the facility.

Entry Fee guarantees 3 games.

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Game Rules:

All games will start on time and at the same time. Games are limited to 25 minutes. The team who gets the ball first will be determined by a coin flip. Games will be played by 1's and 2's to 18. If the time runs out before you reach 18 the team who is ahead will win. If the game is tied there will be a coin flip to see who gets the ball. Once this is determined the first person to score wins.

The ball must be checked and thrown in on each possession. A player cannot drive off the initial "check".

An official/score keeper will be on each court.

Two point baskets will count as 1 point and 3 point baskets will count as 2 points. The shooters feet must be behind the 3 point line for the shot to count as 2 points.

If a player is fouled in the act of shooting and miss the shot, they will get one free throw worth 1 point. If the player makes the free throw the possession goes to the defensive team. If the player misses the free throw it goes back to the offensive team.

If a player is fouled in the act of shooting and they make the shot the shooter gets one free throw. Make or miss- it goes to the defense.

Non shooting fouls will be handled in the following manner: on and after the 7th team foul, one free throw will be shot worth 1 point. If a player makes the free throw the opposite team gets the ball. If the player misses the free throw they retain possession.

Both teams will warm up at the same time on the basket they are playing on. Please be at your basket 15 minutes before game time.

No make it take it. The ball changes possession after each score. On a missed shot the ball must be taken back past the three point line.

Each team is allowed 1 one minute timeout per game. Player substitution is allowed at every dead ball. If a player is injured they must get off the court and stay off until the next dead ball.

The first jump ball will go to the team who did not win the coin flip. It will be alternate possession after that.

There will be no dunking in the games or warm-ups. If you dunk in a game the basket will be taken away and you will lose possession.

Teams are not allowed to stall. Stalling will result in a change of possession. The official/scorekeeper is responsible for calling "stalling".

The team captain is the team spokesperson in EVERY situation.

No Jewelry of any kind will be allowed during play. Taping over earrings will not be allowed.

All other normal basketball rules will be followed. (ie. 3 seconds, out of bounds, etc.)

Technical Fouls:

In the event of player misconduct, flagrant, or intentional fouls, the offended team will be awarded either 2 free throws worth 1 point each or 2 three pointers worth 2 points each.

Fighting or throwing a punch will result in a technical foul and the involved parties will be kicked out of the tournament with no refund.

Divisions and Pricing:

All age levels have a *Men's* and *Co-ed Division*.

There are five divisions you can participate in:

11-13	High School	30 and under
	30 and over	College

All students participating in the college division must have a valid student ID. You **may not compete if you are on a college basketball roster.

ENTRY FEE:

College Division: \$60 per team
